## Hampshire unveils new secure cycle lockers

Hampshire County Council has introduced secure cycle parking lockers at Hythe Pier for commuters using the Hythe Ferry service.

The lockers are being used for the first time in the UK following trials in the USA. The £23,500\* cost of the scheme was partly covered by the DOT's 'Cycle Challenge' initiative.

*\* NB: The £23,500 cost of the project included racks at many rail stations as well as the lockers*
