Nottingham City Hospital doubles cycle storage!

cycle-safe[®] bicycle lockers installed for staff at Nottingham City Hospital have proved to be so popular that more have been ordered to cope with the demand!

Originally twelve lockers were installed as part of the Hospital's Green Transport Plan - that figure has now doubled, and a further eight were installed in the Autumn of 1999. The individual lockers were funded by car parking revenue at Nottingham City Hospital, as part of a major 'cycle-friendly employer' initiative.

Security and Environmental Services Manager Clive Young says "The **cycle-safe**[®] lockers were installed in direct response to requests from cycling employees. They were immediately allocated and there has been a substantial waiting list ever since. I am pleased that we have been able to extend the scheme so that more employees can cycle to work and have a secure place to store their bicycles."
