## cycle-safe<sup>®</sup> BICYCLE LOCKERS REPLACE EXECUTIVE CAR PARKING as part of SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL'S *TRAVELWISE* INITIATIVE

Surrey County Council's Environment Department has **reduced car trips** to its main site at Kingston-upon-Thames by **over 13%** as part of a radical **Company Transport Plan**, with **cycle-safe<sup>®</sup>** lockers playing a vital role in showing that the Council is taking cycling seriously.

Twenty four individual **cycle-safe<sup>®</sup>** lockers for cyclists have been installed in the main quadrangle - replacing the allocated car parking for Senior Management. Staff now have to pass the lockers on their way into the building, which helps to raise the profile of this cycle-friendly initiative.



The secure **cycle-safe<sup>®</sup>** lockers were chosen by planners after extensive evaluation, as their materials, design and stone and brick colour blends in with the historic building.

### Surrey County Council's Company Transport Plan

The Council has recognised the need to promote alternatives to the car for commuter journeys, and is also keen to demonstrate examples of 'best practice'. Other successful initiatives implemented by the Council as part of their **Company Transport Plan** include changes to the working week, job patterns, increased home and teleworking, and improved Public Transport information.
